Results of Tracer Studies Worldwide" (EXLIMA)
Bali, 15-16 November 2018

Tracer study is getting appreciated more and its importance is widely recognized. One push factor is the fact that Information on learning outcomes and transition to the world of work are integrated in many accreditation instrument both at national and international level. Combined with information gathered from employers' perspective, tracer study results often being utilised as key indicators of the success of learning. However, the resources to conduct such studies with a high quality are mostly very limited. Institutional tracer studies need to develop efficient data collection methods, which are different from those of the well established research institutes. Similar or even bigger challenges are faced by employer study in which experiences and learning on methodology and approaches are not as deeply discussed and shared as in tracer study.

With the conference an account of the approaches and the findings of both tracer studies and employer studies should help both to understand the potentials of these studies and to analyze the worldwide state of knowledge on how education can contribute more successfully to the subsequent career of graduates.

The international conference EXLIMA 2018 aims at serving the exchange of information on tracer studies both methodologically and content-wise:

- *To deepen the understanding of the links between curricula, learning, competences and graduate employment and work,*
- *To discuss the use of tracer studies and employer studies for quality assessment, accountability and ranking,*
- *To discuss how tracer studies and employer studies have to be designed and implemented in order to elicit the most valuable results,*
- *To bring researchers from VET/TVET and HE together,*
- *To contribute to the development of international standards of tracer studies and employer studies (objectives/questions and methodology).*

This international conference continues and deepens the work of the first two international tracer study conferences which were held in Bali 2012 and 2015 with more than 300 participants from Africa, America, Asia and Eropa
